



HKSH Village Volunteers Walk For A Vision Notes to Beneficiary

Introduction

1. Established in April 2009, HKSH Village Volunteers (HKSH VV) has become an approved charitable organisation since 2018. HKSH VV which consists of HKSH staff members, doctors, nurses, nursing students, alumni of the School of Nursing and retired staff, has been taking part in various community and fundraising activities in order to promote the health and wellness of people in Hong Kong through care and love.
2. The annual Walkathon "Walk For A Vision" which takes place every March or April, is one of the major fundraising events organised by the HKSH Village Volunteers. It has so far raised funds for Ebenezer School & Home for the Visually Impaired, Make-A-Wish Hong Kong, The New Voice Club of Hong Kong, The Children's Thalassaemia Foundation, St. James' Settlement, Ronald McDonald House Charities of Hong Kong, Little Life Warrior Society, Hong Kong Brain Foundation, Children's Cancer Foundation, Families of SMA Charitable Trust, Enlighten Hong Kong and Children Cancer Care, Senior Citizen Home Safety Association, and Sweet Home Psychological Wellness Centre, Hong Kong Arthritis & Rheumatism Foundation, and Charles K. Kao Foundation for Alzheimers Disease.

Application of Sponsorship

1. Applicants should be a charitable organisation under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance that have a project / programme in need of funding which is focused on improving the medical health of the community. HKSH Village Volunteers is looking for projects that will have a positive impact on the largest number of lives. Funds raised for this project will be available three months after the walkathon.
2. Sponsorship seekers should submit a brief letter and an application form, containing a brief description of your organisation and its goals and objectives, the amount requested, and an explanation of the intended use and allocation of the funds. You may also include other supporting information that may be helpful in our review. 3. Applications are welcome throughout the year. Only one Beneficiary is supported in each walkathon with a maximum funding amount of HKD500,000. The confirmed Beneficiary will be notified three months before the date of walkathon. Applicants should submit their applications by end of November if they would like to apply for the beneficiary in the next year.

Consent to Sponsorship

1. The Beneficiary will provide a letter of consent to the sponsorship raised through Walk For A Vision.
2. The Beneficiary will provide proof of document to identify the non-profit status, e.g. exemption letter from Inland Revenue Department, company registration, etc.

Acknowledgement of Sponsorship

1. The Beneficiary shall acknowledge HKSH and / HKSH Village Volunteers in publication materials, a ceremony or any other means related to the sponsored project as agreed.
2. The Beneficiary will provide a report of the sponsored project within three months after the completion of the project.
3. The Beneficiary will inform the HKSH Village Volunteers of any amendments toward the sponsored project.
